TACTICAL FIREARM INSTRUCTOR DEVELOPMENT

Course Description:

This course is Instructor Development level training. Course is geared towards current instructors, tactical team members, and leadership that train others in the use of deadly force, and specifically those who are responsible for developing the firearm skills of those they train.

The Student Instructor will experience a set of effective fundamental concepts that will facilitate shooting skill development. Training will include methods to transfer the concepts and skills to others, along with a model of how to train others in the tactical application of those skills.

The student's knowledge, shooting, and training skill level will be increased through an intensive, dynamic, and progressive training format. Students will learn how to develop their shooting skill to a level where they can demonstrate "on-demand" a proficiency of shooting that is effective in deadly force combat, where both accuracy and time are of consequence.

Training consists of 3 days of instruction that will prepare the student to:

- (a) Develop their individual shooting skill to a "demonstrate on demand" level
- (b) Utilize 'fundamentals' that are simple and easily applied by their students
- (c) Diagnose shooting performance issues with their students
- (d) Implement training concepts which transfer to effective use of deadly force

Certificates of training will be issued to those who successfully complete this course. This is an Instructor development continuation of training class, not an instructor certification course.

- Bottled water/ sport drink (hydration)
- Knee Pads (Optional-Recommended)
- SWAT vest & gear for SWAT Officers

Training Certificates will be issued to those who successfully complete the training. Students will be required to sign a liability waiver at start of training. Students committing safety violations will be excused from further training with no refund of tuition.

Registration will be confirmed on receipt of full tuition. The preferred method of payment is by check, made payable to **Practical Edge Shooting**.
